
AT-920 Flight Inspection System Delivered to US Army

March 2003 - Airfield Technology has recently completed a contract for the supply of a semi-automatic AT-920 flight inspection system to the US Army.

The new AT-920 system was delivered to the United States Army Air Traffic Control Activity (USAATCA) at Fort Rucker.



The new system will be used to support the flight inspection and maintenance of US Army navigation aids in the continental United States and abroad. The acquisition of the portable system provides the USAATCA flexibility in addressing overseas requirements that cannot be reached using the King Air B200 based at Fort Rucker, Alabama.

A training class was provided for the Army personnel at Fort Rucker following delivery of the system. Because the system is very easy to operate, training was completed in only a few days.

Integration of the system to the B200 for flight inspection was completed in a single afternoon.
